

Youth Team Member Job description

Requirements

- Adult leaders must have participated regularly in the life of the congregation for at least 3 months before serving as a Youth Team Member.
- Adult leaders who regularly work with youth must sign necessary forms to submit to a background check at any given time.
- Be a Christian in good standing and have a heart for youth ministry
- Adhere to the principles and ideas developed by the Youth Pastor and Youth Team
- Complete an interview session with Youth Pastor or Youth Team
- Must be a year removed from high school
- Cannot be in a dating relationship with a current youth member

Expectations

- Be supportive and positive of youth pastor and other Youth Team Members
- Attend monthly Youth Teams and any provided trainings
- Notify youth pastor in advance (**preferably at least 24 hours before services and 2 weeks before events**) of absence for Events, Youth Team meetings (**must attended 8 out of the year**) and evening youth services. Youth pastor assumes that every youth team member can attend scheduled events and services.
- Follow up on commitments made to youth pastor or youth team.
- Be involved in the lives of the student through conversations, email, phone, or attendance at a school function to the extent that time permits.
- Commit and serve in areas of need for the youth ministry such as photography, food organization, AVL, etc.
- Commit to serving on the Youth Team for at least one year.

- If for any reason you need to resign please give at least two weeks' notice.
- Be a Godly role model in all aspects of your life

The youth pastor maintains the right to evaluate youth team member's involvement in youth ministry program and in rare situations the dismissal of youth team member when requirements and commitments are not kept.
